The fire two weeks ago in town that claimed two lives is being investigated by the Sheriff's Department and does not appear to have been maliciously started.

A representative from ISO (Insurance Service office) will be here tomorrow.

Jim Lawson has painted the exterior face of the fire station. It looks great. He is waiting for a lift to be delivered to complete painting the tower.

John Clark has a bench that was made in honor of his late wife Erlene. John is donating the bench to be placed in front of the fire station. Chris Sharp built the bench and will install it with bolts into the concrete.

There have been several small fires near town recently. CDF arrested and interviewed one person.
